



TEST THE BATTERY

Without a correctly functioning battery, you're going nowhere - literally. If your battery isn't checked properly and regularly you could break down and your vehicle productivity could be affected.

Your battery should always be fully charged so you can deliver, perform and execute successful deliveries every single day. In turn, increasing your overall vehicle productivity.



LOOK FOR LEAKS

Before you get started on any other checks, make sure you're prioritising leaks first. Check under the vehicle to see if there are any spillages, observe the colour of any leaks and always get leaks professionally checked. If you overlook this basic check, you can affect a vehicle's function, you can affect the mechanical wiring inside the vehicle and it can even result in explosions. It's not one to miss!



CHECK THE ENGINE OIL

Engine oil should be checked regularly when your vehicle is switched off. When checking the oil, look out for the oil level, check the consistency of the oil and observe the colour. If you notice thick, gritty or even dark coloured oil - it's time to get the oil changed.

If it's been sat dormant, the moving parts in your vehicle won't get the lubrication they need to function properly. Not to forget, all engine oil leaks need to be repaired professionally as soon as possible to ensure the safety of your team is at the forefront of your business operations.

(A) INSPECT THE TYRES

A visual check of the tyres should be performed to make sure they're in good condition - free of punctures and holes. Air pressure should be checked and adjusted accordingly too, to ensure they're the recommended psi.

Keeping your tyres in excellent condition will extend the life of the tyres, improve overall vehicle safety and maintain fuel efficiency. Also, don't forget your spare tyre too - it's essential for any emergencies that might occur so they need to be a good backup.

BODYWORK CHECKS

Bodywork checks should always be performed before you carry out a journey. You need to make sure any issues are identified and aren't delayed. If they are, corrosion and damage will only get worse and this will affect the performance of your cooling system and any goods being transported.

If you do discover any damage, make sure you seek professional advice and assistance and get them sorted as soon as possible. They're a worthwhile investment.

NOTICE WARNING SIGNS

Any issues that occur, be aware of them and ensure you notice the warning signs early. If you have any doubts, it's time to get things checked over as soon as possible. Regular maintenance checks are essential and although they might need more time to cater for them, they shouldn't be pushed to the side.

KEEP IT CLEAN
